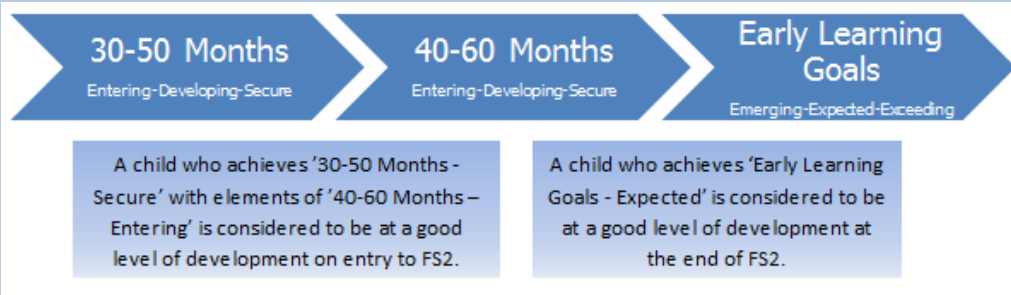
Assessment in the new National Curriculum – ‘Life After Levels’

Information for Parents & Carers

- There is a new National Curriculum from September 2014 and the existing system of assessment levels has been removed and not replaced by the Government.
- This change will affect children in Y1 – Y6 from September 2015.
- The Government have left it up to schools to design their own assessment framework. This school is using the ‘STAT Sheffield’ assessment approach.
- This year, children in Y1 – Y6 will be assessed using steps which describe their attainment against the National Curriculum statements for each year group.
