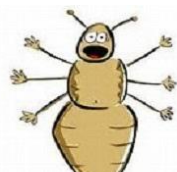

**Reminder** – Please could we remind you that the car park at the front of the school is only for staff parking, disabled parking and Taxi drivers. No parking on the zigzag lines please.



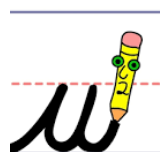
